## Above and UnderGROUND Paper Craft

## INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Stack two paper plate together.
- 2. Mark the center of the plates. (can lightly fold in half to find center).
- 3. Carefully punch a hole through both plates on your mark, large enough for the brad.
- 6. Draw a wavy line below the hole all the way across the plate.
- 7. Cut the top plate only on your wavy line.
- 8. From left over plate cut turning tab.
- 9. Staple tab to back of half plate at top center.
- 10. Insert brad through hole in both plates and fold brad on back.
- 11. Draw an Above ground picture on top plate and half of bottom plate.
- 12. Holding the tab, turn the bottom plate until the bottom half of your Above ground picture is hidden.
- 13. Then draw an Under ground picture on the half of bottom plate.
- 14. Option Punch a hole in tab so you can hang on wall. Now turn your plate to see Above ground and Under ground!
