The First Day of Winter SOCK SNOWMAN



SUPPLIES:

- 1. Child's tube sock (shoe size 3-9).
- One cup dry navy beans.
- Polyester fiberfill (stuffing).
- 4. One thin pipe cleaner or 1 rubber band.
- 5. One fluffy pipe cleaner.
- 6. Glue.
- A varied assortment of items to decorate snowman such as buttons, pebbles, bottle caps, sticks or pipe cleaners for arms.

DIRECTIONS:



You can use sock right side out or inside out depending on what surface texture you want on your snowman.



You may want to make a paper funnel to make it easier to pour beans into sock.



Fill sock with one cup dry navy beans.

The First Day of Winter SOCK SNOWMAN



Fill rest of sock to ridged ankle with polyester fiberfill.



Tie off sock at ankle with thin pipe cleaner or rubber band.



Gather sock to make neck of snowman. Secure with fluffy pipe cleaner.



Turn down top of sock to make cap for snowman.



To attach arm make tiny hole in side of snowman.

Put small amount of glue on tip of arm.

Insert arm in hole.



Apply glue around hole to better secure arm.

Glue decorative items on snowman (much easier if snowman is on his back).
