GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Supplies: heavy paper or 9" paper plates, scissors, stapler, carbon or some sort of transfer paper, pencil, 2 paper clips, Optional—colored markers or crayons.

- 1. The patterns can be downloaded and printed or copied on heavy paper (e.q. index stock) then skip to step **7**—or enlarged pattern to fit 9" paper plate.
- **2.** Cut out circle outline of pattern.
- 3. Using 9" paper plate as template cut out circle of carbon/transfer paper (carbon paper can be reused).
- 4. Paper clip carbon paper and pattern to the bottom of paper plate.
- 5. Trace both dotted and solid lines on pattern.
- 6. Lightly tranfer points A, B etc. on plate so you will be able to erase them when creature is finished. Remove pattern.
- 7. Cut on dotted lines, discarding shaded areas. Do not cut solid lines! Refer to pattern as you cut plate to make sure you are not cutting on solid lines.
- FOLD = there is a crease.
- BEND = there is no crease.
- CURVE = cylinder shape.
